2) Match the Map symbols to the descriptions

No.	Map Symbol	Insert Matching Letter	Description
1			a Earthwall – ditch/wall of earth
2			b Earthbank – vertical earth slope
3			c Single distinctive (Odd) tree – a tree that is different than surrounding trees, easier to identify by looking up.
4			d Man made object (special feature can be signs or even rusted vehicles)
5			e Rock face(small Cliff /crag a vertical rock)
6			f Fence
7			g Small knolls- tiny hills they tend to be mounds about 1m high
8			h Building – (walls and roof are intact – a ruin is a different symbol)
